For eighty years this narrow gauge railway has delighted countless thousands of young and old alike. Its eleven steam locomotives and two diesel engines ply the 13-mile length of track, carrying enthralled passengers between the Cinque Port town of Hythe and the shingle spit of Dungeness with its fishermen's cottages and beach-based fishing fleet.
