His first major project was a number of videos and DVDs of the East Anglian Coast. His first book *A Broads-Eye View* also produced in partnership with Pauline Young, was a huge success, followed by their books *Norfolk Coast from the Air*, *Suffolk Coast from the Air* and *A Broads Eye View 2*.
