

10 Leisure Walks of Discovery A Boot Up ULLSWATER

Ullswater, claimed to be England's most beautiful lake, is certainly the most accessible of the English Lake District's lakes being only 5 miles from the M6 at Penrith. Surrounded by Wainwright's Far Eastern and Eastern fells Ullswater offers visitors and locals alike a host of activities.

The book ranges widely around the lake, associated valley and surrounding mountains and valleys from Rheged on the A66/A592 to Brothers Water. It also includes Dalemmain, Pooley Bridge, Ullswater Steamers, Aira Force, Moor Divock, Martindale, Boardale, Grisedale, Brothers Water and Hartsop.

In line with other books in the series 10 walks surrounding the lake have been selected with the majority being short and easy; suitable for a half day with family or groups of friends, but also including a couple of more challenging walks to give a taste of the fell walking also available.

ABOUT THE AUTHOR

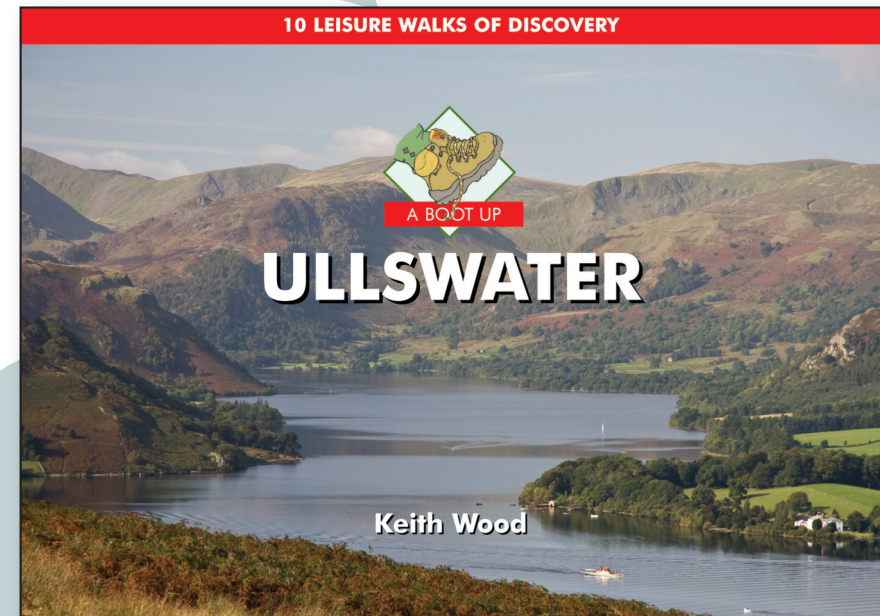

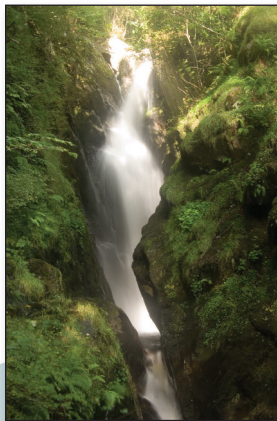

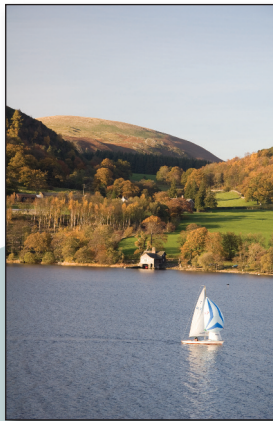

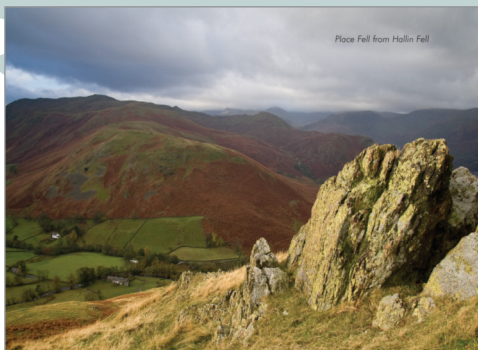

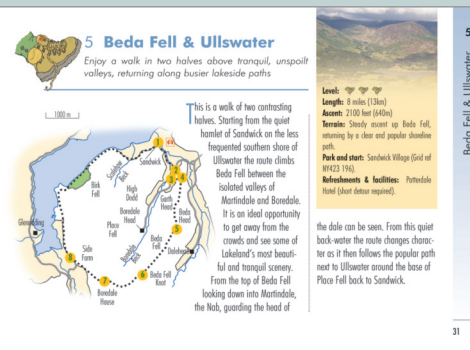
