As she grew her understanding, insights and technique broadened to the point that today she exhibits her photographs internationally.

In this superb volume, she describes through personal account how an individual's experience may affect how they see and react and how she has encompassed this within her work – a continuous process of observation and gaining new skills to be able to portray her images as archival pieces of art. These superlative photographs are truly born from life as lived.

Janice Alamanou's photographs are exhibited in the UK and internationally. She is represented in galleries in Norfolk, Florence, Austria, Barcelona and America. 
