A Merchant Seaman's Story, 1942-47

Tony Hopkins

Britain's Merchant Navy played a crucial and sometimes underestimated role in the Second World War. Tony Hopkins was just seventeen when he signed up as an apprentice in late May 1942 with the famous Alfred Holt and Company (Blue Funnel Line). Over the next five years Tony was to serve on seven different ships before "swallowing the anchor" in 1947. During those years, Tony was involved in the Battle of the Atlantic, torpedoed off the coast of West Africa, and helped supply the Allied forces in North Africa in Operation Torch and in Normandy after D-Day in 1944. His account of these experiences, written later in life, forms the centrepiece of this book. Tony writes with a keen eye for detail, a wry sense of humour and a sure grasp of the story teller's art as he describes life aboard a British merchant ship at a pivotal time in the nation's history.

An introduction and historical notes written by Tony's son David give further context and background. Peter Kerr-Dineen takes up Tony's story after 1947 describing his fascinating subsequent career in shipping as well as his charity work for the Shipwrights' Company.

Illustrated with contemporary photographs and documents, this book tells the story of one young man's part in events that stretched across the world and how the experience of his time at sea shaped the rest of his life.


